

Yard Waste

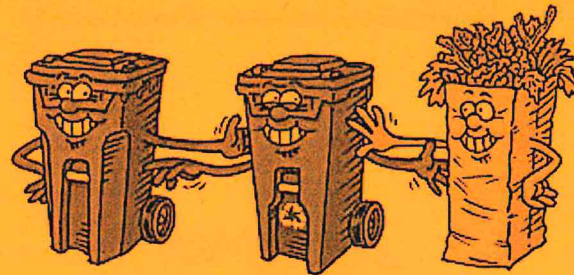
- Yard waste must be curb-side by 7AM and placed within 6 feet of the roadway.
- Please place grass clippings or palm “boots” in boxes or other open containers and stack palm fronds with stems facing toward the street. **Do not** place any yard waste in plastic or paper bags.
- Yard waste placed in alleys or vacant lots **will not** be picked up.
- Vacant lot owners may call 386-517-2000 for special pick-up service and be charged accordingly as determined by the Sanitation Supervisor.
- Residential customers are allowed up to eight 32-gallon containers or one brush pile no larger than 3 x 6 x 6 feet. If your amount exceeds this limit, a special pick-up fee may be charged and determined by the sanitation supervisor.

City Ordinance 86-19 prohibits sanitation crews from picking up any waste defined as the following: earth, trees, construction materials or debris, roofing material, plaster, concrete, or any other substance that may accumulate as a result of building operations or repairs, or as a result of clearing lots or tree removal.

Wednesday

North of Highway 100,

South of Gamble Rogers State Park.

Garbage

- Garbage containers should be curbside by 7AM and placed within 6 feet of the roadway.
- Container capacity should not exceed 32 gallons.
- Refrigerators, freezers and large ice chests that are dangerous to children must have the doors removed.
- Large furniture should be broken down into pieces that can be handled by one man.
- Household hazardous materials can be disposed for free of charge at Flagler County Recycling & Household Hazardous Waste Facility.



Recycling

- Recyclables must curbside by 7AM and placed within 6 feet of the roadway.
- Recyclables are available to all Flagler Beach residents at no charge. Please call 386-517-2000 to arrange delivery.
- All recyclables may be mixed together in the same bin.

The following is collected curbside:

- Cans: steel, tin and aluminum
- Plastic with a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 code
- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Phone Books
- Cardboard
- Shredded Paper (bagged)
